SENTENCE DETAILS: COUNT 1

Commit to Commissioner of Corrections

Ordered on February 25, 2026:

- Commit to Commissioner of Corrections at the MN Correctional Facility - St. Cloud for 24 months.
Sentence is stayed for 5 years.
Conditional release after confinement has been set at 5 years.

This sentence consists of a minimum term of imprisonment equal to two-thirds of the total executed sentence, and a maximum supervised release term equal to one-third of the total executed sentence, unless the sentence is life or life without the possibility of release.

Local Confinement

Ordered on February 25, 2026:

- Defendant is sentenced to 90 days in the Washington County Jail.
Defendant is to serve 90 days on Work Release.
Credit for time served amount is 3 days.
- Work release criteria waived. Start date to be coordinated with supervising probation officer

Monitoring

Ordered on February 25, 2026:

- Defendant is placed on supervised probation for 5 years, monitored by Washington County Community Corrections.

Enter and complete sex offense treatment as recommended in psychosexual evaluation, including aftercare, and follow all program recommendations. Program to be approved by your probation officer. No unsupervised contact with minor females under the age of 16 in private settings Submit to polygraph testing as directed by your probation officer, or treatment program No use, purchase, or possession of any electronic devices that can access the internet unless/until approved by probation officer. Provide and maintain updated inventory of all internet-capable devices to your probation officer. No use of internet chat lines, internet dating services, and/or social media sites unless approved by your probation officer. Electronic devices and/or storage devices may be subject to random inspection/search. Monitoring software may be installed on any of your electronic/storage devices at your own expense as directed by your probation officer. No entering strip clubs, adult oriented bookstores, or receiving massage services unless approved by your probation officer. Do not use or possess sexually explicit, or pornographic materials unless approved by your probation officer and/or sex offense therapist.
