TERMS OF DISPOSITION OR SENTENCE: COUNT 3

Offense Description: Distribute via Electronic Communication Material that Relates/Describes Sexual Conduct to a Child
Offense Date: January 01, 2025
Level of Sentence: Felony

SENTENCE DETAILS: COUNT 3

Commit to Commissioner of Corrections

Ordered on December 15, 2025:

- Commit to Commissioner of Corrections at the MN Correctional Facility - St. Cloud for 20 months.
Sentence is stayed for 5 years.
Conditional release after confinement has been set at 15 years.

This sentence consists of a minimum term of imprisonment equal to two-thirds of the total executed sentence, and a maximum supervised release term equal to one-third of the total executed sentence, unless the sentence is life or life without the possibility of release.

Local Confinement

Ordered on December 15, 2025:

- Defendant is sentenced to 30 days in the Olmsted County Jail.
Defendant is to serve 30 days on Weekends.
Credit for time served amount is 3 days.
- defendant shall arraign with his probation agent how this sentence will be served - but it shall begin in 30 days.

Monitoring

Ordered on December 15, 2025:

- Defendant is placed on supervised probation for 5 years, monitored by Olmsted District Court.

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Conditions

Ordered on December 15, 2025:

Defendant must comply with the following conditions:

- Follow all State and Federal criminal laws.
- Contact your probation officer as directed.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you have contact with law enforcement.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you are charged with any new crime.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you change your address, employment, or telephone number.
- Cooperate with the search of your person, residence, vehicle, workplace, property, and things as directed by your probation officer.
- Sign releases of information as directed.
- Give a DNA sample when directed.
- Do not use or possess firearms, ammunition or explosives
- Attend sex offender program including aftercare
- No unsupervised contact with persons under age 18 No contact with minor females unless approved in advance by probation agent. do not frequent locations where children congregate such as parks, playgrounds, schools, day cares, bicycle trails, shopping malls, or other places as designated by probation agent. do not hold any positions of authority over any children, this includes but is not limited to, babysitting, lifeguarding, camp counselor, etc,, unless approved by community corrections.
- Submit to Polygraph Examinations as Directed
- Maintain employment obtain and maintain housing and employment as directed by probation agent.
- No Access To or Use of Internet Without Approval comply with internet monitoring software and be financially responsible for the cost of monitoring if access is approved by probation agent. comply with Internet Usage agreement if permitted to access the internet and as approved by probation agent and not access computers or the internet unless approved in advance by probation agent.
- No Social Media, No Internet May not use/create any media method for personal contact and/or advertisement for solicitation purposes.
- Predatory offender registration required
- Sign Probation Agreement
- No mood-altering chemicals
- Not Possess/Use Any Pornographic/Sexually Explicit Material No use of backpage.com, craigslist.com or other internet websites used to promote escort services or prostitution. Provide full access to all electronic devices, such as cell phones and computers and login passwords to any social networking accounts.

Service

Ordered on December 15, 2025:

- Defendant is ordered to perform community work service for 100 hours.
- Shall receive hour for hour credit for participation in pro-social activities including treatment, counseling, AA/NA meetings, etc.

Concurrent/Consecutive

- Concurrent with Count 3.

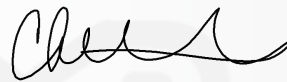
