SENTENCE DETAILS: COUNT 1

Local Confinement

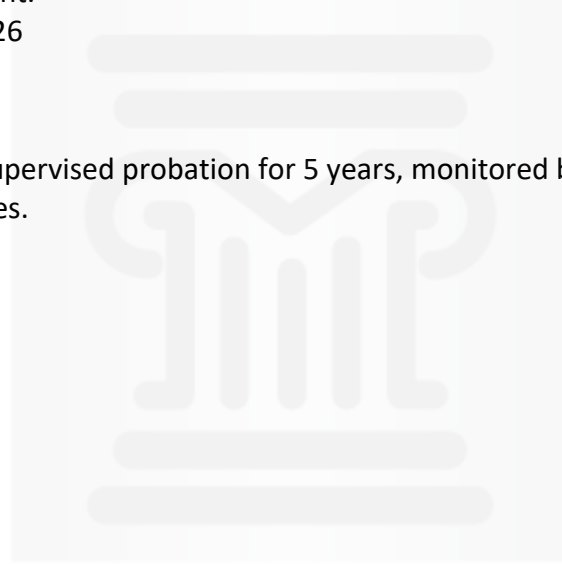
Ordered on March 04, 2026:

- Defendant is sentenced to 120 days in the Renville County Jail.
Defendant is to serve 120 days.
Credit for time served amount is 6 days.
 - The Defendant is entitled to ordinary jail privileges under M.S. 631.425 while serving any time in custody, including work release and sentence to serve, if eligible for either program under the rules of the Sheriff's Department.
- Start Date: March 17, 2026

Monitoring

Ordered on March 04, 2026:

- Defendant is placed on supervised probation for 5 years, monitored by MN Department of Corrections - Field Services.



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Conditions

Ordered on March 04, 2026:

Defendant must comply with the following conditions:

- Follow all State and Federal criminal laws.
- Contact your probation officer as directed.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you have contact with law enforcement.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you are charged with any new crime.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you change your address, employment, or telephone number.
- Cooperate with the search of your person, residence, vehicle, workplace, property, and things as directed by your probation officer.
- Sign releases of information as directed.
- Give a DNA sample when directed.
- Do not use or possess firearms, ammunition or explosives
- No contact with persons under age 18 female persons under age 18.
- No contact with victim(s)
- Do not ship/transport/possess or receive firearm or ammo
- Remain law-abiding
- Predatory offender registration required be in compliance with all requirements of registration.
- Submit to Polygraph Examinations as Directed
- Psychological-Sexual Evaluation already completed. Follow all recommendations of the evaluation.
- Attend sex offender program
- Individual Therapy sessions in conjunction with his treatment program at minimum once monthly, and ultimately as directed by his treating therapist.
- Not Possess/Use Any Pornographic/Sexually Explicit Material A program should remain placed on his computer and any electronic devices that could potentially allow him access to the internet to assist his corrections agent with monitoring this issue
- Abstain from use or possession of alcohol and nonprescribed, mood altering chemicals, which includes any product containing cannabis You must submit to random testing at your own cost. Law Enforcement or probation may request random testing without probable cause to verify abstinence.
- Obtain employment establish and work toward maintaining full-time employment
- Attend Support Groups as Directed by Probation
